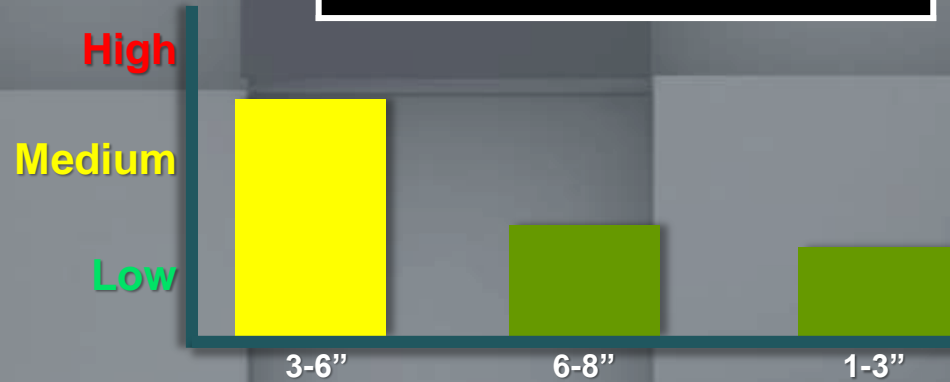

# Additional Details

## Impact Details

- Light to moderate snowfall
- Slightly higher amounts near Monroe, MI
- Some blowing and drifting of snowfall

## Snow/Ice Details

- Storm track is crucial as to where the heavier and lighter snowfall is located.
- Northern areas will see lower amounts.
- Southern areas will see the highest amounts.

## Forecast Confidence Details

Confidence in the forecast is moderate as the track of the system will be key as to exactly where the lightest and heaviest snow sets up. A track further north than forecast will bring higher amounts northward toward Detroit.

## Other Details

- Strong winds will create blowing and drifting snow hazards.
- Wind chills will be in the single digits. Ensure crews are dressed appropriately for the wind chill and take occasional breaks in a warm area.
- Highs on Sunday will be in the low to middle teens.
- Wind chills look to drop to -5° to -10°F on Sunday.
